Exhibition Application FAQ's

What is Revealed?

Revealed is an annual event celebrating the diversity, talent and passion of contemporary Aboriginal Art practice in Western Australia. Since its inception in 2008, Revealed has grown into an unmissable event on the arts calendar. The annual program brings WA Aboriginal art centres and independent artists to Perth for an exhibition, art market, and more.

Who can apply to exhibit?

Aboriginal artists who consider themselves to be new or emerging are encouraged to apply. Artists must identify as Aboriginal and must have a connection to Western Australia.

What is meant by new and emerging?

A "new and emerging" artist refers to an artist who is in the early stages of their artistic career. They may have begun creating professionally but are still developing their style, gaining recognition, and building their body of work. Established Aboriginal artists can also apply, however, their artwork must be a new medium or creative practice that is new to the artist or be an example of an emerging style or approach to art making.

When are you accepting applications?

Applications are now open and will close on Sunday 10 November 2024. You can submit your application here >>

Is there a cost to submit works or to exhibit?

No, it is free to submit artworks and if you are selected to exhibit in the Revealed exhibition there is no cost to participate. If selected, you will be responsible for arranging and covering the cost of transporting your artwork.

What mediums can I submit?

Artworks of all mediums are accepted. This includes but is not limited to painting, drawing, digital, photography, ceramic, textile, fibre, sculpture, installation and experimental works.

Do I need to be a member of an Aboriginal Art Centre to apply?

No, all WA Aboriginal artists are welcome to apply, and we strongly encourage applications from both art centre artists and independent artists.

Is there a limit to the number of artworks I can submit?

Artists may submit up to 8 (eight) artworks.



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Can I submit a work that is currently incomplete, but will be ready in time for the exhibition?

Yes, both completed artworks and artworks in progress can be submitted. If the artwork is not complete at the time of submission, please give a detailed description of the final artwork that will be made (size, medium, story, price). Please also include photographs of the artwork in progress for consideration by the selection panel.

Are there any size limits for the artworks?

There is no strict size limit, and the selection panel will consider all artworks submitted.

However, due to the large volume of artworks exhibited in Revealed each year, gallery space does limit the size/number of works that can be displayed. Artworks smaller than 1.2m are generally most suitable for this exhibition.

Do all artworks need to be for sale?

No, but we encourage you to submit works that you would like to sell!

How are works selected for the exhibition?

All submissions are assessed by an independent panel made up of Aboriginal artists/Aboriginal Arts Industry specialists.

What are the 2025 exhibition dates?

Friday 4 April to Sunday 15 June 2025

*If you are selected to exhibit in Revealed, your artwork will need to be on display in the gallery for the entirety of the exhibition period.

Where is the 2025 exhibition being held?

Perth Institute of Contemporary Art

Can collaborative artworks (made by more than one person) be entered?

Yes. Please list all artist names in the submission form.

How do I submit my artwork/s?

When will I be notified about the selection process?

Early December 2024 via email.

If my artwork is selected for the exhibition, by what date does it need to arrive at the gallery?

17 February 2024

If I apply for the exhibition, am I automatically considered for a stall at the art market?
