Martumili Artists

Sarafina Dickie was born in Perth and grew up in Jigalong. She has been painting with Martumili Artists since 2020 and originally learned to paint under the guidance of her Nana [LMintern (dec.)] and alongside artist Corban [Clause Williams].

Sarafina has been connected to Martumili and The Arts long before her painting career. Spending much of her adolescence working with Martumili collecting grass for weaving and travelling out to the many communities that are a part of Martu Country to support Art making activities.

Today Sarafina assists with the daily operations of Martumili's studio in Newman and continues to support On Country trips through her work with both Martumili and Kanyirninpa Jukurrpa - the local ranger organisation. Recently Sarafina was a core part of the Martumili 'Return to Punmu' Project where she assisted Artists with family ties to Punmu, to return to the Community, share ninti (knowledge) with the younger generations, and undertake a collaborative painting.

Sarafina completed the first part of the Our Future training in August 2025 and will complete the Our Future training program in November 2025.
