Broome Circle - Artists Away From Home Program

I'm a Karrajarrri woman from Bidyadanga, now living in Broome, WA. I work as an Arts Worker at Broome CIRCLE with the Artists Away From Home program. The program supports artists from remote community art centres when they are in Broome build their skills, share their stories, and stay connected to culture through community arts.

I have experience working with creative projects and helping organise community events that share stories and culture. I've been part of local exhibitions and gatherings where people come together to show their art, share their voice and keep culture alive.

In 2023, I participated in the professional development program for Revealed in Fremantle, where I gained new skills in exhibition installation, art administration, marketing, and social media. I also curated and installed artworks in an exhibition at Lawson Flats with AACHWA in Perth. It gave me the opportunity to work with art centres and encouraged me to keep learning and growing.

I live in the country, where I feel a strong connection to the land and the sea and the people around me. My community has taught me the value of listening, sharing and respecting what has been passed down to us.

I was recently invited to be a curator for "Radical Futures" the arts triennial for the Kimberley. I found it exciting and rewarding to collaborate with another art center. When I went to Kununurra for the selection. It gave me the opportunity to learn new skills and work alongside other curators. I would like to continue learning from others.

I really enjoyed the Broome Show, Art on the Move came and did some training. Dora Giffiths from Kununurra and I chose art and placed them on the walls. I learnt so much, we had artists that came to explain what their artworks were about, it was very interesting.
